Anti-Bullying Policy

As a Club we take bullying very seriously and no form of bullying will be tolerated.

There are several forms of bullying including:-

- Emotional – being unfriendly, excluding, sending hurtful text messages, tormenting.
- Physical – pushing, kicking, hitting, punching or any use of violence.
- Sexual – unwanted physical contact or sexually abusive comments.
- Racist – racial taunts , graffiti, gestures.
- Homophobic – because of or focussing on the issue of sexuality.
- Verbal – name -calling, sarcasm, spreading rumours, teasing.

Incidents of bullying should be reported either to the Child Welfare Officer, a member of committee or Swimline. (See notice board for details)

Serious cases of bullying will be referred to the ASA for advice.
